

Studio

- Addressed an issue with the “Go Live Automatically” setting not being removed from a source when a new source is given the property.
- Updated the Hive integration to use Shaka plug-in 7.0.
- Updated Studio to allow WebRTC tunneling via port 443.
- Addressed an issue with the iOS mobile presenter app returning an error when trying to connect to Studio.
- Added tokenization with the CDN (Akamai) for Studio slides.
- Addressed an issue with Amplify where it was caching 404 errors for many seconds, instead of caching them at 0 seconds.
- Addressed an issue with the CDN chart in the Studio Monitor Tool not displaying.
- Update the delivery of Studio handouts (attachments) to be handled through the CDN.
- Addressed an issue with HLS, where the media playback would intermittently stop. This was affecting iOS devices viewing a Studio webcast.



- Addressed an issue with the Marketo transfer screen where the “with activity” checkbox was not being saved.



- Updated the Show Setup API to escape the booth type description in the API results.
- Addressed an issue with the elements on the registration page not copying over during a show copy.
- Addressed an issue on a mobile where when using a login link with a redirect to a booth after authenticating, the user was brought to an error page on the mobile device.
- Addressed an issue with group chat rooms, where entered messages were not displaying in the correct sort order.
- Updated the 1:1 private chat to remove hyperlinks from displaying. Any link that is entered will display in plain text.
- Addressed an issue with 1:1 private chat text not wrapping within the chat window.
- Updated the space builder setup to limit the scheduled video chats allowed per space type to 10.
- Updated the Activity Digest calendar reminder links to use https.
- Updated the max characters that are displayed for an attachment title in the resource center to 255 characters.
- Updated the storage location for video collections to use cloud storage. Previously, these files were stored at the data center.

- Added support for Firefox 86.
- Added support for Chrome 89.
- Updated the CPE calculation to remove unnecessary duration checks and sync reporting to show the same duration values for CPE reporting.
- Addressed an issue with the ShowKey not getting parsed correctly on the URL for an IDP initiated SSO login.
- Addressed an issue with marketing automation transfers not executing when an attendee type was not defined.
- Addressed an issue with the show/webcast copy function where it was inserting duplicate records into the template.
- Addressed an issue with marketing automation transfers not properly handling registration dates for two-factor registrations.
- Addressed an issue with the second screen authentication method “Email & Name Login Method”, where after an unregistered user signed in, they were brought to an error page.
